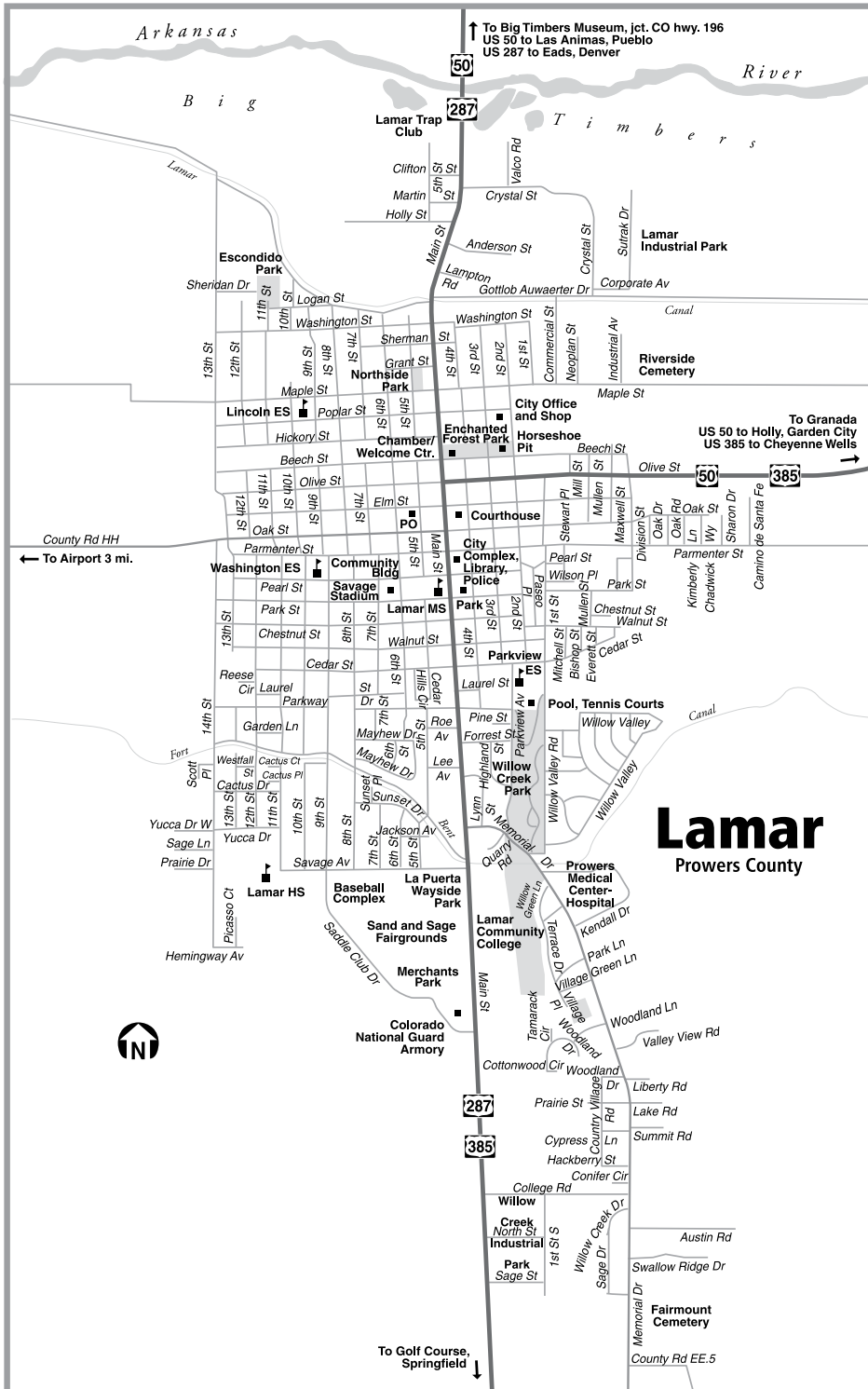
Sand and Sage Fair Parade
