Back to School Means Vaccine Updates

The Prowers County Public Health and Environment Department reminds parents that Colorado law requires students in Colorado schools to be immunized against certain vaccine-preventable diseases. School entry requires vaccinations for DtaP, IPV, Hepatitis B, MMR as well as two doses of Varicella for children entering kindergarten through 4th grade, one dose of Varicella for children 5th through 12th grades and one dose of Tdap for students 6th through 12th grades.

Vaccinations clinics are scheduled for the following dates and times:

- Tuesday, August 9th 9-12, 1-5
- Thursday, August 11th, 9-12, 1-7
- Tuesday, August 16th, 9-12, 1-5
- Thursday, August 18th, 9-12, 1-5
- Tuesday, August 23rd, 9-12, 1-5
- Tuesday, August 30th, 1-7

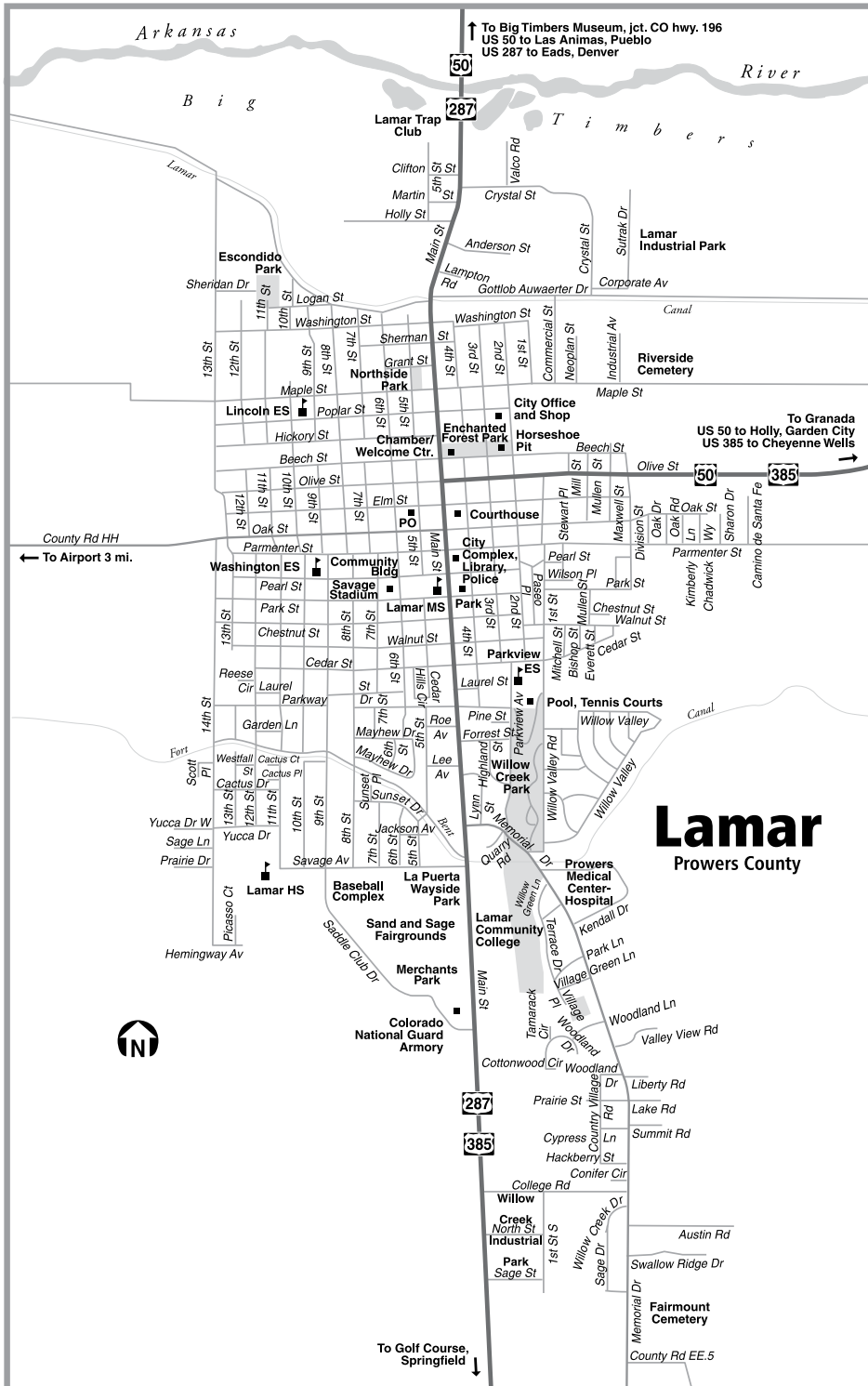
