DENVER — Tuesday, Nov. 22, 2011 — In observance of Thanksgiving, many state offices will be closed on Thursday, Nov. 24.

State driver's license offices, the Department of Public Health and Environment's vital records office, Division of Wildlife Service Centers and administrative offices for executive branch departments will be among the facilities closed Thursday.

The Lamar Public Library will also be closed Thursday, November 24th, Friday, November 25th and Saturday, November 26th and will reopen Monday, November 28th at 9:00 a.m. The Community Building will be closed on Thursday, November 24 and Friday, November 25, 2011 in observance of the holiday but will reopen on Saturday, November 26th, 2011.

Commercial refuse collection scheduled for Wednesday pickup will be collected on Tuesday, November 22nd and refuse scheduled to be collected on Thursday will be collected on Wednesday, November 23rd. Commercial refuse collection scheduled for Friday will remain the same.

Residential refuse collection scheduled for Thursday will be collected on Wednesday, November 23rd; this includes the Willow Valley area and the Parkview subdivision. Residential refuse collection scheduled for pickup on Friday, will remain the same. Please have your containers in place by 6:00 a.m.
