Flu vaccinations will be available for both children and adults free of charge. Prowers County Public Health & Environment would like to encourage ALL residents to take advantage of this free clinic if they haven't already received their flu vaccination. Anyone who wants to reduce their chances of getting the flu can get vaccinated however those who are considered high risk should especially be vaccinated. It normally takes 2 weeks after receiving the flu shot for the body to build immunity against the flu so there is still time to help reduce the chance of getting the flu.

Having received the resignation of P. J. Wilson, the City of Lamar is encouraging qualified residents to apply to fill Mr. Wilson's unexpired term. All interested applicants will be interviewed during the City Council's work session on March 26, 2012 and the appointment will be made subsequent to that meeting or at a later time.

The City's Charter requires the City Council to fill the unexpired term by appointment within 30 days after the vacancy occurs. April 9, 2012 is the last regular Council meeting within that 30 day period.

To qualify for appointment, an individual must be registered to vote, a citizen of the United States for at least one year, have resided in the City of Lamar for at least the past year, not have a felony conviction nor hold any other elected public office, not be a salaried employee of the City of Lamar, and must currently reside in Ward II.

Ward II is somewhat irregular in shape. It is generally that area between Eighth Street and Main Street, but it also includes the area north of Olive and east of Main Street, the area north of Washington Street and west of Eighth Street and the area east of Main Street which is bounded by Parkway Drive on the north, Parkview Avenue on the east and the Fort Bent Canal on the south. Anyone having a question on whether their home is in Ward II or not can obtain further information from the City Clerk's Office.

An application form may be picked up at the City Administrator's Office, 102 East Parmenter, Lamar, CO and must be returned no later than 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 7, 2012.
