James "Red" Heath Scholarship Available


Prowers County Farm Bureau is pleased to announce its 2012 scholarship program in honor of James "Red" Heath, for high school seniors in Prowers County.

The Prowers County Farm Bureau will provide up to four, \$300 scholarships to high school seniors who reside in Prowers County or attend high school in Prowers County. In addition to these scholarships, there will be one, \$600 scholarship awarded to a senior that most exemplifies the high qualities and community involvement that made James "Red" Heath a valued member of our communities.

To be eligible for the scholarships, a high school senior must fill out an application and submit it to the Prowers County Farm Bureau. Applicants are encouraged to enter college in an agriculture related field of study.

The deadline for return of the application is April 11, 2012.

Applications may be obtained from guidance councilors at any of the high schools in Prowers County or at the Prowers County Farm Bureau office located at 313 South 5th in Lamar.
