

Drought Assistance Available

Colorado NRCS has an EQIP Drought Assistance Program Available for Rangeland Producers.

Those affected by the D4 drought and within 30 miles are eligible.

The program offers cost-share to producers, who will defer their rangeland. The program is for a minimum of two years of cost-share with the possibility of an extension for 3 years. Producer must have control of the land for 4 years.

If interested, please see your local Colorado NRCS office as soon as possible. Applications must be in by Friday, August 31, 2012.
