FROM THE PROWERS COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR

The Prowers County Board of Commissioners is accepting letters of interest from persons who are residents of Prowers County to fill one (1) vacancy on the Southeast Colorado Regional EMS and Trauma Advisory Council (SEC-RETAC).

Council Members are required to meet on a quarterly basis. Meetings are regularly scheduled at 12:00 p.m. on a Wednesday each quarter. Additional meetings may be required as needed. Council Members are responsible for representing Prowers County in the various duties and responsibilities of the six (6) County SEC-RETAC. The SEC-RETAC is a board consisting of three (3) representatives from each county. The Board is responsible for creating and directing regional goals and objectives for the betterment of emergency medical and trauma care (both hospital and pre-hospital) within the region including Bent, Baca, Crowley, Kiowa, Otero, and Prowers Counties.
