Town of Holly Water Main Project

The Town of Holly Water Department has scheduled a water main replacement project which will impact customers who reside on W. Cliff Street, between 7th and 8th Streets. The project is slated for the week of September 17-21, and will include bypassing the old iron main with a new PVC line, and the installation of new water meters at each residence.

Customers in this area will experience both temporary and moderately extended discontinuance of water services intermittently throughout each day of the project. Water customers in the project area can plan ahead for the outage by remembering to draw water sufficient for daily needs before the shut off each morning. It is expected that water service will be restored to residences at the close of each work day.
