## Lamar Police Make Two Drug Arrests, Days Apart

Between Thursday of last week and this past Monday, April 22, the Lamar Police Department arrested two persons in two separate incidents involving the Schedule 1 drug, methamphetamine. Acting on a search warrant, police arrested 52 year old Gregory Leschinsky at 508 West Logan Street. Undisclosed amounts of narcotics and items relating to the distribution of meth were found. Additional charges are pending on other individuals in the residence during the arrest. Leschinsky was held on a \$50,000 bond.

The other arrest occurred on Monday when police, acting on information stopped a vehicle driven by Christopher Fox on Picasso Court, near the end of South 14th Street in Lamar. Mr. Fox was arrested for Possession of a Schedule 1 Controlled Substance, methamphetamine, and an outstanding Prowers County warrant. He was transported to PCJ and is being held on \$50,000 bond.

## National Drug Take-Back Initiative

The Lamar Police Department will be participating in the National Drug Take-Back Initiative in cooperation with the Drug Enforcement Administration on April 27, 2013 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The program is designed for people with unwanted and unused prescription drugs to safely dispose of those medications. The collection point will be in the front of the south end of the city complex. Please feel free to pull into the front driveway from Parmenter Street and exit at Pearl Street. There will be representatives on hand to assist with the collection. There is no charge for the collection of the prescription medications. No needles or other medical supplies will be collected during this time. Anyone with old or unwanted medications are encouraged to take part in the program.
