LCC Receives over \$1million Grant

Lamar Community College received \$1,092,663 from the U.S. Department of Labor Wednesday, September 18, as part of a \$25 million grant to a consortium of nine Colorado schools focused on developing skilled advanced manufacturing workers throughout the state.

Participation in Colorado Helps Advanced Manufacturing Program (CHAMP) will allow LCC to enhance and expand its welding program by adding employer-driven content and reorganizing the current certificate into smaller, stackable certificates. In addition, other equipment will be purchased to enhance the program.

The three year grant, which is a part of the government's Trade Adjustment Assistance Community College and Career Training grant program, gives LCC an opportunity to grow a program that could greatly impact the community of Lamar and surrounding areas.

"These grant monies will enhance our ability to provide world class training in welding and other manufacturing processes," stated John Marrin, LCC president. "It was funded at the perfect time as we were already moving forward to provide more training of this nature."

Other schools receiving funds to participate in CHAMP are Aims Community College (\$2,106,296), Community College of Denver (\$3,534,061), Emily Griffith Technical College (\$417,734), Front Range Community College (\$9,925,073), Pikes Peak Community College (\$2,307,859), Pueblo Community College (\$1,656,914), Red Rocks Community College/WarrenTech (\$1,946,047) and Metropolitan State University of Denver (\$1,958,663).

Two Car Crash in Kiowa County

Colorado State Patrol is Investigating a Two Vehicle Accident - The Colorado State Patrol is investigating two vehicle crash that occurred on Colorado Highway 287 near milepost 112, approximately 1/2 mile east of Eads, CO.

A 1998 Infinity sedan was being driven by Juanita Hammer (39 yoa female from Eads, CO), and a 2009 Chevrolet Pickup was being driven by David Wancura (54 yoa male from Salida, CO). Hammer was travelling northbound and Wancura was travelling southbound on Colorado 287. The two vehicles collided (side-to-side), which caused both vehicles to rotate. Both vehicles came to rest on the highway, which caused Colorado 287 to be closed for approximately 2 hours.

Hammer was transported to Weisbrod Memorial Hospital in Eads. Hammer was later transported to Prowers Medical Center.

Wancura was treated at Weisbrod Memorial Hospital and later released.

Alcohol and drugs are considered to be possible factors in the crash. Investigation into the crash is on-going.
