

Junior Livestock Sales Report

Bent County Fair: Sixty-one animals sold through the annual Junior Market sale, down from 64 in 2012. Support for the program was strong with an average premium per animal of \$1190 in 2013.

Cheyenne County Fair: Twenty-two 4-H and fourteen FFA members exhibited livestock at this year's fair. Fifty-eight animals were sold through the junior livestock auction for a total of \$113,659.25.

Kiowa County Fair: Twenty-six 4-H and fifteen FFA members exhibited 143 head of livestock at the Kiowa County Fair. Seventy-one animals were sold in the junior livestock premium sale to total \$59,550. Over \$6,500 was donated for livestock pens at this year's fairgrounds.

Prowers County Fair: This year's livestock sale posted another increase and came in at \$137,165. Prowers County sent 46 general projects to the Colorado State Fair competition and there were two grand champions: Kylee Holden for modeling and Cassidie States for foodcore projects.
