It was determined by the County Clerk's Office that Ronald E. Manly submitted enough numbers of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2014 General Election ballot, Tuesday, November 4, 2014.

Because he registered as an unaffiliated candidate Manly was not involved in the June 24, 2014 Republican Primary Election in Prowers County. That run-off decided that Sam Zordel would go on the November ballot by defeating candidate Ron Trowbridge.
