REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL – PROFESSIONAL SERVICES MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE CITY OF LAMAR, COLORADO

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAMAR, COLORADO hereby solicits and requests applications for the position of Municipal Judge for the Municipal Court of the City of Lamar, Colorado, a Home Rule Municipal Corporation.

The person selected to fill this office shall assume the duties of the office on January 1, 2015.

Qualifications for Municipal Judge:

- 1) The municipal judge appointed by the City Council shall be a qualified elector of the City of Lamar, shall be a high school graduate, or shall have attained the equivalent of a high school education as indicated by the possession of a certificate of equivalency issued by the Department of Education, based upon the record made on the general educational development, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that preference shall be given to the appointment of municipal judge who is licensed to practice law in Colorado or who is trained in the law.
- 2) The municipal judge must demonstrate knowledge of and familiarity with the Colorado Municipal Court Rules of Procedure, the Charter of the City of Lamar Colorado, and the ordinances of the City of Lamar Colorado.
- 3) Applicants for the municipal judge position shall disclose the existence of any past, present, or future relationships, of whatever nature, that may constitute a conflict of interest with the City of Lamar, the Lamar Municipal Court, or which may tend to disqualify the applicant in any manner by reason of the existence of such conflicts. In addition, applicants for the municipal judge position shall disclose the existence of any past, present, or future matters which would give the appearance of impropriety or the appearance of a conflict of interest. These matters shall be considered and evaluated by the City Council in its selection of the municipal judge.

Applications must be returned to the City Administrator's Office by 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, October 15, 2014.

General Election Up-Date from Prowers County Clerk & Recorder

Media Release: 2014 General Election - Ballots will start arriving in mailboxes October 14-17, 2014, for the 2014 General Election on November 4th.

Mail ballots will be sent to all eligible voters to the address listed on their voter registration record. After voting you can choose how to return the ballot; by dropping it off at a ballot box at your County Clerk & Recorder's Office or by returning it in the mail. Correct postage is required for delivery. Ballots must be received by 7 p.m., on Election Day to be counted and postmark dates do not count as received.

Prowers County will also offer voter services at Voter Service and Polling Center (VSPC). Voters may visit our VSPC to update your address, request or replace a ballot, or to register to vote (through Election Day).

Your ballot drop-off and VSPC location, hours and other information are: Prowers County Clerk's Office, 301 S. Main St., Ste. 210, Lamar, CO. Hours of operation are October 20th – November 3, 2014, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Saturdays, October 25th and November 1st, 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4th, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
