April Is National Child Abuse Prevention Month

April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month. The focus this year is the role that every community member can play in valuing children and strengthening families. In an effort to raise awareness, the Prowers County Department of Human Services is partnering with the Prowers County Child Protection Team to sponsor several events in April which will focus on child abuse prevention and the importance of community involvement in the prevention of child abuse.

Thousands of Colorado children suffer abuse or neglect every year. Locally, DHS receives approximately 200 calls annually. The statistics can be overwhelming, but they are reminders that no one can afford to look the other way.

In an effort to promote greater safety for Colorado's Children, the Colorado Department of Human Services has launched a new statewide child abuse and neglect hotline at 1-844-CO-4-KIDS. Designed to provide one, easy-to-remember phone number for individuals to use statewide to report suspected child abuse and neglect, the hotline serves as a direct, immediate and efficient route to Colorado's 64 counties and two tribal nations, which are responsible for accepting and responding to child abuse and neglect inquiries and reports. All callers will be able to speak with a call-taker 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Everyone can find a way to make a difference so that children reach their potential. The Child Abuse Prevention Month theme, "Prevent Child Abuse and Neglect: We All Can Play a Part in Making Meaningful Connections" promotes the need for meaningful involvement by parents, concerned individuals, communities and organizations.

April 8 Meeting on Prairie Chicken Status Set for Holly

In March 2014 the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service listed the lesser prairie chicken (LPC) as a "threatened species." A "threatened" listing is a step below "endangered" under the Endangered Species Act and allows more flexibility in how the Act protections are implemented. In June 2014 the Center for Biological Diversity filed suit to list the LPC as "endangered." If the bird is listed as "endangered," the livelihoods of farmers and ranchers and their rural communities will be significantly and negatively affected.

Prowers County Farm Bureau and Colorado Farm Bureau are part of a coalition to prevent an "endangered" listing for the Lesser Prairie Chicken. The coalition is sponsoring a meeting Wednesday, April 8th, beginning at 10 am, in Holly. The meeting will be held at the Catholic Hall, located at 113 South 6th street.

Baca, Kiowa and Prowers Counties in Colorado are all included in the habitat area of the LPC. Farmers, ranchers and business owners from those and adjacent counties are urged to attend this meeting.

Kansas Farm Bureau Legislative Counsel Mike Irvin and Foundations Director Harry A. Watts will brief attendees on the impact of an "endangered" listing of the lesser prairie chicken. The meetings are open to the public.

Invitation for Bid - Sprinkler System

Lamar Housing Authority is accepting sealed bids for the replacement of the sprinkler system at 206 East Cedar, Lamar, CO. The areas to be bid include the parcel of land beginning at Building C and finish at the north/south sidewalk located on the east side of Building G. All contractors must view property and determine soil conditions, water sources and pressure, and plant life. For an appointment to view property, call the Maintenance Supervisor for Lamar Housing Authority at 719.688.9642. A drawing to scale of the system to be installed showing head to head placement, number of zones, and locations of lateral and main lines will be required to be included with all bid information. Lines will be placed 8 -12" in ground. No heavy equipment will be used and all trenches need to be filled and leveled for reseeded. All materials necessary for the sprinkler replacement should be included in the bid documents including PVC pipe, Rain Bird heads, wire, clocks and valves. All completed work must provide a 1 year warranty on labor and 3 years on parts. Contractor will be required to winterize and start up system the first year. All bid documents must be sealed in an envelope, clearly marked "Bid Document" and delivered to Lamar Housing Authority, 804 South Main, Lamar, CO 81052, by April 15, 2015, at 4:30PM. All sealed bids must be clearly marked LHA Sprinkler Bid 2015-01. No late submissions will be accepted. Persons submitting bids must have Workman's Compensation Insurance as well as Liability Insurance coverage and proof of such coverage must be included with the bid documents. Bids received without proof of insurance coverage will be rejected. All bids will be opened at the regularly scheduled Lamar Housing Authority Board meeting on April 20, 2015 at noon. Installation of the new sprinkler system will begin immediately after the award has been made and completed by June 30, 2015. Bid forms may be picked up at the Lamar Housing Authority Office, 804 South Main, Lamar, CO, or mailed to prospective bidders upon request.
