Don't Jump the Gun for Spring Clean-Up

Some tree limbs are too large and will not be handled. They must be bundled and are limited to a two inch diameter by four foot limb and weigh no more than 30 lbs per bundle. Leaves must be bagged, not loose!

Place your items at your front curb by 7am Saturday. Accepted items include: tires, latex and oil base paint, treated wood, empty oil filters, tree limbs and yard waste, bagged leaves, refrigerators, freezers, washers/dryers, tv and computers. Invitation to Bid

The Town of Granada will receive sealed bids up to 2:00 pm on the 14th day of May, 2015 and will open said bids at 2:30 pm that same day at the Town of Granada Clerk's office in Granada located at 103 South main Street, Granada, CO 81041 (ph#: (719) 734-5411) for the below mentioned project.

The project consists of Hot Mix Asphalt overlay starting at the south end of Hoisington Street and running north to tie into US 50. This area of the project will consist of concrete gutter, curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk work, concrete handicap and curb ramps, and minimal embankment and base course work. Additionally, the project will run from the intersection of US 50 and Hoisington to the intersection of US 50 and Main Street. This area of the project will continue to replace concrete sidewalk, concrete curb and gutter, concrete handicap and curb ramps. New construction of concrete sidewalk and placement of drainage pipe. Both areas will have signage and epoxy pavement markings.

The project is funded by the CDOT Safe Routes to School and a percentage of local matching funds. It is subject to Federal and State contracting requirements, including Davis-Bacon wages, EEO requirements, etc. The UDBE Goal for this project is 0% and the OJT hours is 0. Contractors do not need to be on the CDOT contractor pre-qualified list.

Plans and Specifications are available at the Town of Granada Clerk's office located at the above mentioned address. A non-refundable deposit of \$25.00 is required at the time of plans pickup. Checks can be made out to: Town of Granada. Credit Cards will not be accepted.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting is scheduled for May 7th at 2:00 pm located at the Town of Granada Clerk's office located at above mentioned address. Only those bidders who attend the meeting will be allowed to bid the project.

The CDOT Form 347, Certification of EEO Compliance, is no longer required to be submitted in the bid package. This form certified that the contractor/proposed subcontractors were in compliance with the joint Reporting Committee EEO-1 form requirements. The EE0-1 Report must still be submitted to the Joint Reporting Committee if the contractors and subcontractors meet the eligibility requirements (29CFR 1602.7); we will, however, no longer require certification.
