### Yard Sale Tips & Tricks 4 Miscellaneous Prep Tips

There are plenty of potential problems that are easy to overlook when preparing for your yard sale. Below are three things to keep in mind that should help make your sale run more smoothly.

### Lamar Man in Custody After High Speed Chase

This past Monday, June 1, 2015 at approximately 0730 am, the Colorado State Patrol responded to Colorado 385 in Cheyenne County on a report of a stolen pickup and flatbed trailer. The pickup was located on Colorado 385 south of the town of Cheyenne Wells.

The Cheyenne County Sheriff's Department located the vehicle and attempted to make contact with the vehicle. The driver eluded the deputy on multiple county roads, with speeds reaching excess of 100mph. The driver traveled off the county roads and into various fields. The vehicle was later located in the middle of a wheat field west of Colorado 385.

Multiple surrounding agencies assisted with the search for the vehicle. The two suspects, Glenn Groover (23 year old male from Lamar) and Samantha Huddleston (21 year old female from Pueblo) were located in the wheat field and taken into custody. The case is still under investigation.
