Two Ball Fields Done, Two Closer to Completion

Work has been steadily progressing to complete the remaining two softball fields at the Lamar Sportsplex ever since a final GoCO grant was approved for the City this past spring. Last week, work was underway to place the final sets of field lights for the third and fourth ball parks. Each post will hold a crossbar containing four lights.

Lamar Parks and Recreation Director, Rick Akers, was on hand with crews from Lamar Light and Power, installing several 20 foot tall cylindrical cement anchors into a 12 foot hole dug by an auger. The sides were sufficiently smooth and wide enough to allow a Light and Power crane to lift the anchor base off the ground and then thread it into the hole. Once positioned, it was braced in place until additional concrete could be poured. Once that set, the metal pole and lights will be wired and the installation will be completed.

"We have five of these going in around the two fields," Akers explained and added that one of the finishing touches would be installing sod in the fall. This saves the city crews from having to continually water the sod during high summer heat and allows the new grass a chance to take root before the next playing season begins.

Some of the final portions of the completion project included chain link fencing around the fields, backstops and the two dugouts as well as the installation

of the two sprinkler systems. Once preliminary funding was available for the Sportsplex, construction began in 2008 and the first field was completed in time for Lamar to host its first Cal Ripkin World Series games in the summer of 2009. *By Russ Baldwin*

The Town of Granada will receive sealed bids up to 2:00 pm on the 30th day of July, 2015 and will open said bids at 2:00 pm that same day at the Town of Granada Clerk's Office in Granada located at 103 South Main Street, Granada, CO 81041 Ph#: (719) 734-5411 for the below mentioned project.

The project consists of Hot Mix Asphalt overlay starting at the south end of Hoisington Street and running north to tie into US 50. This area of the project will consist of concrete gutter, curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk work, concrete handicap and curb ramps, pipe drainage, minimal embankment and base course work, signage and epoxy pavement markings.

The project is funded by the CDOT Safe Routes to School and a percentage of local matching funds. It is subject to Federal and State contracting requirements, including Davis-Bacon wages, EEO requirements, etc. The UDBE Goal for this project is 0% and the OJT hours is 0. Contractors do not need to be on the CDOT contractor pre-qualified list.

Plans and Specifications are available at the Town of Granada Clerk's Office located at the above mentioned address. A non-refundable deposit of \$25.00 is required at the time of plans pickup. Checks can be made out to: Town of Granada. Credit Cards will not be accepted.

A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting is scheduled for July 16th at 2:00 pm located at the Town of Granada Clerk's Office located at above mentioned address. Only those bidders who attend the meeting will be allowed to bid the project.

The CDOT Form 347, Certification of EEO Compliance, is no longer required to be submitted in the bid package. This form certified that the contractor/proposed subcontractors were in compliance with the joint Reporting Committee EEO-1 form requirements. The EEO-1 Report must still be submitted to the Joint Reporting Committee if the contractors and subcontractors meet the eligibility requirements (29CFR 1602.7); we will, however, no longer require certification.
