Jerry Nelson to Perform at First Baptist Church in Holly

Internationally-celebrated concert pianist, Jerry Nelson, has established himself as one of the world's premiere performers, having performed on all continents. He has teamed up with Dino and Anthony Burger, and accompanied such artists as Glen Campbell, Sandi Patti, Tom Netherton and Steve Amerson.

As a composer, arranger, conductor and studio producer, he has conducted orchestras from London and Tel Aviv to Nashville and Los Angeles. His creative touch appears on over 500-recorded projects working with sons Scott and Brad. His publishing and arranging efforts include several dozen original songs and over 5,000 arrangements.

Jerry's first "official" assignment was playing piano at age 10 in a small Minnesota church. He began his career in public school music also in Minnesota followed by over three decades arranging and directing orchestra at Denver First Nazarene Church. But today, Jerry and Rachel are focused on full-time concert career.

Much of the proceeds of their efforts enable occasional trips to the Congo and Zimbabwe where Jerry performs concerts and Rachel works with AIDS victims and youth peer groups. They also work with humanitarian programs including economical water purification and advanced education for promising youth. Retirement, Jerry says, is not yet on the radar screen. Jerry will be performing in concert on Sunday, July 26, 2015 at 10:30 A.M. at the First Baptist Church, 512 West Colorado in Holly, Colorado. There is no charge for admission.

The project consists of Hot Mix Asphalt overlay starting at the south end of Hoisington Street and running north to tie into US 50. This area of the project will consist of concrete gutter, curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk work, concrete handicap and curb ramps, pipe drainage, minimal embankment and base course work, signage and epoxy pavement markings.

The project is funded by the CDOT Safe Routes to School and a percentage of local matching funds. It is subject to Federal and State contracting requirements, including Davis-Bacon wages, EEO requirements, etc. The UDBE Goal for this project is 0% and the OJT hours is 0. Contractors do not need to be on the CDOT contractor pre-qualified list.
