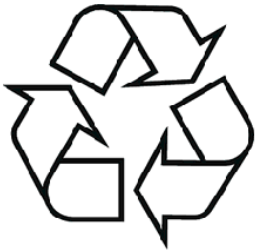


Prowers County Commodity Distribution
