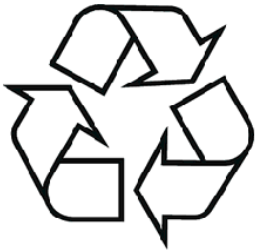


### Social Security Via Video
