Pesticide Applicator Continuing Education Credit Workshops

Colorado State University's Southeast Area Extension is offering a Pesticide Applicator Continuing Education Credit Workshop in Lamar at the Prowers County Annex Building on November 19, 2015. The training is aimed to provide new information on pest control, health and environmental safety, pest management technology and changes in pesticide laws and regulations. The workshop provides all 7 credits required for both private and commercial applicators to be re-certified to renew their pesticide applicator license without retaking the test.

The workshop fees are \$45 for both private and commercial pesticide applicators. Plastic and E-Waste Recycling Program Has New Hours and New Location

Lamar Partnership's Plastic and E-Waste Recycling Program has changed locations from the Lamar Thriftway Parking North Parking Lot. The recycling container will now be located at 103 N. 2nd St. This is located near the City of Lamar's recycling containers at Public Works, right North of the railroad tracks, across from Lamar Light and Power.

Along with the move comes extended hours for the plastic recycling portion of the program. Patrons will be able to purchase and drop-off recycling bags inside the Public Works office

Monday through Friday from 9am to 3pm, and every second and fourth Saturday of the Month from 10 am to 1 pm. E-waste recycling hours will remain every second and fourth Saturday from 10am to 1pm.

All proceeds from the Plastic and E-Waste program benefit the Main Street program and go towards the rejuvenation and improvement of our Historic Downtown District. Baca County Resident Dies in Highway 287 Crash

The Colorado State Patrol is investigating a crash, which resulted in a single fatality. The crash occurred Friday, November 6, 2015, on Colorado Highway 287 approximately two miles north of Springfield, Colorado, in Baca County.

A Hesston Swather Tractor was traveling northbound on Colorado Highway 287, while a 2007 GMC Yukon Ambulance was also traveling northbound on Colorado Highway 287. The 2007 GMC collided with the Hesston Swather, causing the GMC to travel through the southbound lane and off the west side of the roadway, while rolling 1/2 times. The GMC came to rest on its top on the west side of the road, while the Hesston Swather came to rest on its wheels on the paved portion of the east shoulder.

The driver of the Hesston Swather was identified as 21 year-old Caleb Yocam, out of Two Buttes, Colorado. Mr. Yocam was transported to a local hospital with minor injuries.

The driver of the GMC was identified as 74 year-old Larry Miller of Springfield, Colorado. Mr. Miller was wearing his seat belt at the time of the collision, and was transported to a local hospital with minor injuries.

The rear passengers of the GMC were identified as 96 year-old James Wyatt out of Springfield, Colorado and 63 year-old Rick Hartley out of Springfield, Colorado. Both parties were transported to a local hospital. Mr. Wyatt suffered minor injuries, while Rick Hartley was pronounced deceased at the hospital by attending physicians.

The crash remains under investigation.
